



Advestigo launches its range of security solutions for enterprises and announces the first immediate release of AdvestiCHECK™.

Saint-Cloud, June 26th, 2006: Advestigo, a leading provider of content recognition technology, widely recognized on the Media & Entertainment Market, launches its range of security solutions for enterprises.

Nowadays, companies have two priorities when developing secure information systems: to protect their intellectual and industrial property through enforcement of internal security policies and to comply with government security standards, whether international or national (Sarbanes-Oxley, Bâle II).

Advestigo's software solutions make it possible for IT managers to monitor and control data stored on networks and workstations, and to prevent the deliberate or accidental leak of confidential information.

AdvestiGUARD™ solution, that helps prevent the leak of sensitive or confidential information, is currently being tested within pilot customers and will be released end of the year.

The first product, AdvestiCHECK™, released today, makes it possible for companies to monitor and scan IT networks (SAN, NAS servers, etc.) and workstations, and to identify any unauthorized storage of illegal, copyrighted or confidential data.

AdvestiCHECK searches any previously 'referenced' data be that 'structured', such as credit card numbers or customer information, but also 'unstructured', i.e. sensitive information specific to a particular company or to a particular department within a company.

AdvestiCHECK is built on a patented content recognition technology, which leverages digital fingerprint analysis to automatically distinguish between exact copies, approximate copies, and sampled, reformatted or altered copies of original files. It also takes into account file variations caused by reformatting, reframing, dilution, adding information, and so on; it does not depend on any kind of hidden file identifiers like watermarking, electronic signatures, or encapsulation. AdvestiCHECK is currently able to search most Office document formats (text and graphics, various European or Arabic languages) and source code.

A paragraph of 10 lines of text, copied from a product specification into a much larger document of, say, 50 pages would be recognized as anomalous and possibly sensitive, and would very likely be quarantined pending clearance. All documents containing this 10

line paragraph would then be located on servers and workstations, regardless of the format or content of the host document.

With its Enterprise Solutions, Advestigo directly addresses the issues facing companies who need to secure their information systems: protection of intellectual property and observation of security standards. At last, they prove being powerful solutions to enforce NDA between a company and its partners or suppliers.

Advestigo will attend "les Assises de la Sécurité", in October, in Monaco.
